To whom it may concern.

This document details a punctuational offence that has been committed on or about your premises, for which a representative of the AEP feels is your responsibility. This is your official notice of the exchange by the AEP.

It is the mission of the AEP to balance the apostrophe related errors made by members of the public such as yourselves by showing you what is not acceptable in the English Language and what is.

A document such as this will be issued to one offender who displays a superfluous apostrophe, and one to another offender who does not display a required apostrophe. The exchange will be deemed to have occurred when both notices have been issued. Please note, this does not make your offence acceptable, it just makes apostrophe supporters such as members of the AEP feel a little better.
